

Health & Safety message from the Resort Municipality of Whistler

- In accordance with provincial health directives:
 - if you have travelled outside Canada, you are not permitted on our premises until you have self-isolated for a minimum of 14 days
 - Please stay home if you are displaying [symptoms](#) of COVID-19 or you live in a household where someone is showing symptoms of COVID-19
- Anyone displaying symptoms of COVID-19, which primarily displays as a persistent cough, will not be permitted on the premises. If you are sick, please stay home.
- Customers will be asked to sanitize their hands prior to entering the facility.
- Physical distancing is required at all times (minimum of 2 meters). In order to achieve these requirements, Whistler Public Library is limiting the number of customers in the facility and will use signs, marking and one-way travel in the facility.
- An outdoor waiting area with markers is set up outside the facility.
- Failure to observe physical distancing risks the closure of the facility, and as such, you will be asked to leave the premises.
- There are no public washrooms available at Whistler Public Library at this time.
- Whistler Public Library encourages patrons to contact our staff with questions by email or by phone rather than visiting the library in person.
- The RMOW has increased cleaning protocols for commonly touched surfaces consistent with health agency recommendations to ensure the health and safety of our staff and customers. As such, the period between transactions may take longer. We thank customers for their patience.
